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ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.07.2022 for the offences punishable under Sections **341, 294(b), 323, 397 and 506(ii) I.P.C**, in crime No.140 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner robbed a sum of Rs.500/- from the defacto complainant's petty shop at knife point. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that, the petitioner is an habitual offender, that apart from this case, there are six previous case pending against the petitioner. Hence, he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.



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[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
