After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:



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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties along with their respective counsel are present.

2. Both the parties amicably settled the dispute that has arisen between them.

3. Both the parties have agreed for the following terms:

"(i) Over and above, a sum of Rs.5,67,920/- with interest and cost awarded by the Trial Court, the second respondent/Insurance Company has agreed to pay additionally a sum of Rs.9,50,000/- in full quit and the same was accepted by the appellant V.Santhoshkumar."

4. In the above terms agreed between the parties, this Civil Miscellaneous Petition stands disposed of.

5. The second respondent/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the above additional amount of Rs.9,50,000/- as agreed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on such deposit, the appellant is entitled to withdraw the said amount from the Trial Court.
