This is a 'Condonation of Delay' ['COD'] application taken out by 14th defendant *inter alia* with a COD prayer for filing written statement.

2. In the light of the fair stand, which the learned Senior counsel for plaintiff is taking, it may not be necessary to set out the reasons qua COD in great detail. Suffice to say that the applicant has stated that there has been delay in collection / collation of documents and getting instructions leading to delay.

3. Learned counsel for plaintiff submits that the delay sought to be condoned is within the tolerance limit i.e., cap. To be precise, learned counsel for plaintiff submits that the delay sought to be condoned is within 120 days from the date of service of suit summons on the defendant concerned in the captioned application. Learned counsel for plaintiff submits that he is not opposing the prayer and there is no objection to the COD prayer being acceded to.



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4. In the light of the narrative thus far, captioned application is ordered as prayed for. Let written statement be taken on file, if it is otherwise in order. It is open to the plaintiff to file a reply statement if the need arises within the prescribed time lines. There shall be no order as to costs.
