**ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to call for the records connected with the case in Crime No.61 of 2020 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Karimangalam Police Station, Dharmapuri District



and quash the same.

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2. The case is still in the stage of investigation. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. A compromise Affidavit has been filed by both the petitioner and the *de-facto* complainant before this Court, which has been signed by both the parties and also by their respective counsel. All the parties are present and identified by their respective counsel and the Police. In order to identify the respective parties, they have also produced the copies of the Aadhaar Card and it is made part of the record. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the First Information Report pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **2017 9 SCC 641-**



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**(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the First Information Report in Crime No.61 of 2020.

5. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Crime No.61 of 2020, on the file of the Inspector of Police, Karimangalam Police Station, Dharmapuri District is quashed and the terms of compromise affidavit filed by the petitioner and the *de-facto* complainant shall form part and parcel of this Order. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the credit of **Chief Justice Relief Fund, High Court of Madras** within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.
