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ORDER

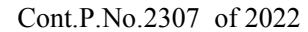
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This contempt petition has been filed for the alleged disobedience of the orders of this Court dated 15.10.2020 made in W.P.No.10805 of 2020.

2. In order to recover the award amount under Workmen Compensation Act by way of Revenue Recovery proceedings, a mandamus was sought for which was granted by this Court by the said order dated 15.10.2020.

3. Pursuant to the said order, when the contempt petition is taken up for hearing today, Mr.Yogesh Kannadasan, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents has submitted that the orders of this Court has been complied with and in support of the same, he has produced a copy of the proceedings issued by the Tahsildar, Sulur dated 05.12.2022, where, *inter alia* the Tahsildar has stated the following:
