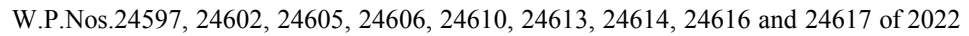

COMMON ORDER

The issue arises in all the writ petitions is one and same. Hence, all the writ petitions are disposed by way of common order.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner land was acquired under the Industrial Purposes Act and no award was passed in terms of Section 7 of the Act. However, the compensation amount was deposited in February 2021 onwards. Thereafter, the petitioner made a representation to the respondents to refer the matter to the competent civil court under Section 8 of the Tamil Nadu Acquisition of Land for Industrial Purposes Act, 1997 for enhancement of compensation. However,



3. The learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that, due to pandemic situation the petitioners were not able to made representations in person and it would suffice, if this Court issues direction to the respondents to consider the petitioners representations and pass appropriate orders within a time frame fixed by this court.

4. Considering the limited request made by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to direct the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's representations starting from 24.12.2021 onwards and on various dates and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order

5. Accordingly, these writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
