This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal has been filed against the fair and decreetal order dated 26.08.2016 passed in HMOP.No.24/2014 by the learned Judge, Family Court, Dharmapuri.

2. The matter was listed to-day under the caption, 'for dismissal' since there was no representation for the appellant before this Court on the last hearing on 07.01.2022.
