These Criminal Original Petitions have been filed to call for the records and quash the complaint dated 22.02.2017 in E.O.C.C.Nos.55 to 57 of 2017 pending on the file of the Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Egmore for the offence under Sections 148(6) read with 148(8) of the Companies Act, 2013.

2. The learned Central Government Standing counsel appearing for the respondent submitted that the complainant has filed a compounding petition before the Regional Director, which is pending for consideration.

3.
