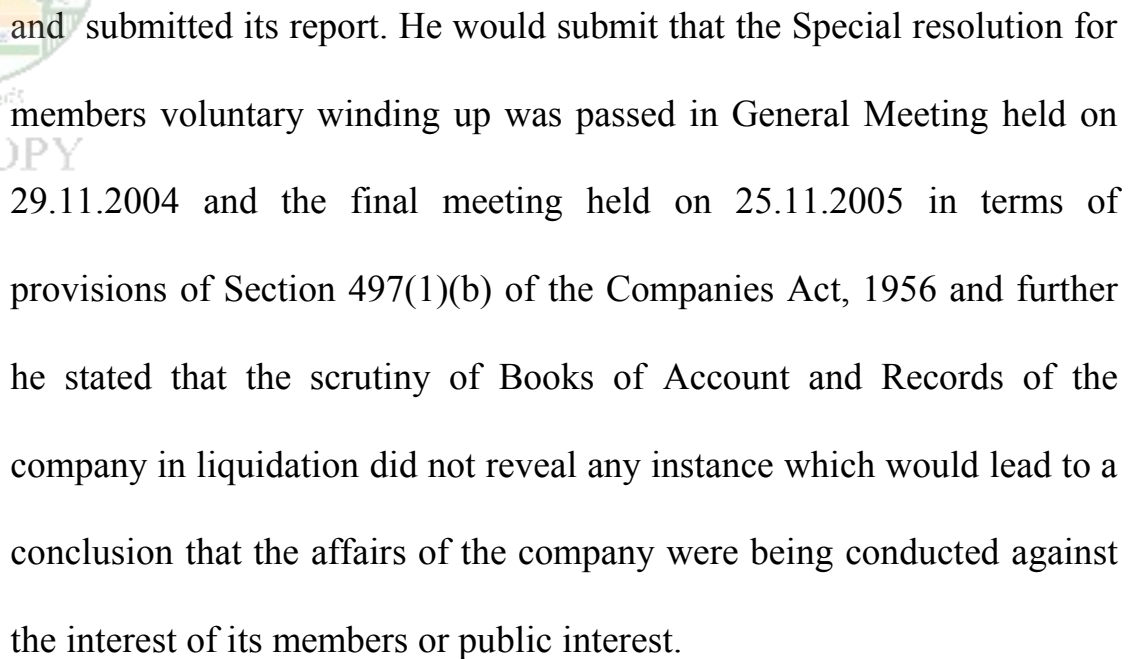
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This application is filed under Section 497(6) of the Companies Act, 1956 to pass an order to dissolve M/s.Marquip India Limited (in Voluntary Liquidation).

2. The learned Official Liquidator submitted that M/s.Marquip India Limited (hereinafter called as company) went into Members Voluntary winding up pursuant to the special resolution passed by its members on 29.11.2014 and Mr.J.J.Bennet was appointed as a Voluntary Liquidator of the company. The Final meeting of the company was held on 25.11.2022 as required under Section 497 (1) and (2) of the Companies Act, 1956. The Voluntary Liquidator appointed by the Company took over the charge of the Company under liquidation. The Voluntary Liquidator has filed his final Statement of Accounts pursuant to Section 497(3) of the Companies Act, 1956 with the Registrar of Companies (ROC). The NOC provided by the ROC on 02.06.2022 and the NOC of the Income Tax Department dated 03.08.2005 are also annexed to the report.

The said report is accepted and this Court is satisfied that all the relevant procedures have been duly complied with and accordingly this application is allowed by ordering the dissolution of M/s.Marquip India Limited, a company in voluntary liquidation as prayed for. Consequently, the learned Official Liquidator is directed to complete all compliances in the above regard.
