



Crl.OP.No.24615 of 2022

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 4(1)(k) @ 24 of TNP Act in Crime No.621 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was in illegal possession of two brandy bottles and 11 beer bottles. Hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he is no way connected with the alleged offence. Hence he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent would submit that already this Court dismissed the petitioner's earlier anticipatory bail petition in Crl.O.P.No.22961 of 2022 dated 22.09.2022. Hence he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
