In the affidavit filed, it had been stated that to avoid multiplicity of proceedings and since the petitioners, who now seek to transpose, also derive title to the property by a settlement deed dated 06.05.2010, it would be appropriate that they are transposed from the rank of the respondents to the rank of the petitioners in the original petition.
