When it was pointed that the Petitioner has an effective alternative remedy to make a complaint under the provisions of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the Writ Petition with liberty to resort to the said procedure and he has made an endorsement to that effect in the court record.

3. In view of the same, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn, granting such liberty. It is made clear that for the purpose of reckoning limitation for availing the aforesaid remedy, the period from the date of filing of the Writ Petition, viz., 20.11.2017, till the date on which the certified copy of this order is made ready by the Registry, shall be excluded.
