This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 181 days in representation of the petition in C.M.P.SR. No.121771 of 2019 in S.A. No.65 of 2014.

Ms. K.Bhanumathi, learned counsel appearing for petitioner submitted that pending appeal, the fourth respondent expired on 15.07.2019 and to implead his legal representatives, the petitioner had filed a petition to bring on record, the same was returned for certain compliance.
