Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.S.VENKATESH, Advocate for the petitioner and of M/S K.SRINIVASAN, SPECIAL PUBLIC PROSECUTOR FOR CBI CASES, on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This Court by an order dated 15.02.2021 suspended the sentence with a condition that the petitioner shall appear on the every first working day of the month before the learned II Additional District Judge for C.B.I. Cases, Coimbatore at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for petitioner that the petitioner is complying the condition regularly for more than one year. Now, the petitioner was diagnosed cancer in his left lungs, he has undergone surgery and he is under treatment. Hence, he is not in a position to appear before the learned II Additional District Judge for C.B.I. Cases, Coimbatore. He would also submit that as the petitioner requires bed rest for atleast three months and



he is aged about 70 years. Hence, he finds it difficult to appear before the trial Court. Therefore, the petitioner has filed this petition to relax the condition.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances and also considering the fact that the petitioner is complying the condition for nearly a year, this Court is inclined to modify the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on the first working day once in six months beginning from 01.03.2022 at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
