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JUDGMENT

This Appeal has been filed by the Insurance Company challenging the quantum of compensation viz., Rs.1,54,600/- (Rupees one lakh fifty four thousand and six hundred only) awarded by the Tribunal on 17.11.2016 made in M.C.O.P.No.130 of 2013 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal/Special Sub Judge, Erode.

2. There is no representation for the Respondents. It is reported that the Claimant has not preferred any Appeal for enhancement.

3.The learned counsel for the Appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present C.M.A., and seeks six weeks' time to deposit the entire amount awarded by the Tribunal.
