ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to give permission and police protection to conduct Cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Singalandapuram Village Arulmigu Sree Chinna Mariyamman Temple Festival at Rasipuram Taluk, Namakkal District on 01.11.2022 between 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 15.10.2022

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct cultural programme on 01.11.2022, from 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m., in the temple festival at Singalandapuram Village Arulmigu Sree Chinna Mariyamman Temple at Rasipuram Taluk, Namakkal District, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 15.10.2022 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (crl.side), appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 15.10.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

7. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
