3. The petitioner challenged the patta issued in favour of the respondents 3 and 4 before the first respondent by way of an appeal, dated 29.09.2021 and it is pending.

Considering the above, the first respondent is directed to issue notice to the petitioner and the respondents 3 and 4 herein and after giving them an opportunity of hearing, pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
