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representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 19.10.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
