The Writ Petition has been filed for directing the Second Respondent to implement the order dated 13.04.2022 passed by the First Respondent to recommend *suo motu* appeal preferred by the Petitioner and cancel the Hereditary Trusteeship of Arulmigu Mariamman Temple, Agaram, Keizpennathur, Thiruvannamalai District held by the Fourth Respondent.
