Prayer : Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to grant permission and police protection to conduct the cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Kottur Village Arulmigu Sree Chinna Mariyamman Temple Festival at Bargur Taluk, Krishnagiri District on 02.11.2022 between 6.00 pm to 11.00 pm by considering the petitioner's representation dated 21.10.2022.

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ORDER

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The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission and police protection to conduct the cultural event viz., Adal Padal (Song and Dance) program to be held on 02.11.2022 at 6.00 pm onwards in connection with the Temple Festival of Kottur Village Arulmigu Sree Chinna Mariyamman Temple Festival at Bargur Taluk, Krishnagiri District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 21.10.2022.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct cultural programme on 02.11.2022, from 6.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m., in the temple festival at Kottur Village Arulmigu Sree Chinna Mariyamman Temple Festival at Bargur Taluk, Krishnagiri District the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 21.10.2022 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.



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3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 21.10.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
