The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 02.10.2022, for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(A), 4(1)(aaa) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, in Crime No.350 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 02.10.2022, on receiving a specific information, the respondent police and his team inspected the petitioner's place, wherein, they found that the petitioner was in illegal possession of 110 litres of ID arrack. Hence the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would also submit that the petitioner is in custody from 02.10.2022 and he is ready to abide by any stringent

conditions that may be imposed on him and hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 110 litres of ID arrack. He would further submit that there are 26 previous cases as against the petitioner, out of which 24 are of similar in nature. Therefore, he vehemently oppose for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent Police and perused the materials available on record.

6. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) and also considering the fact that there are 26 previous cases

pending as against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
