Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 12% per annum for the belated payment of his PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary, to pay the amounts towards 60 days of earned leave surrendered by the petitioner, while he was in service and to settle the amounts payable under the Social Security Scheme, Family Benefit Fund, IRT Contributions and to refund of



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contributions under the Post Retirement Benefit Scheme together with interest at the rate of 12% within a specified time as may be fixed by this Court.

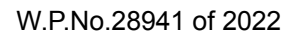

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for a direction to the respondents to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 12% per annum for the belated payment of his PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary, to pay the amounts towards 60 days of earned leave surrendered by the petitioner, while he was in service and to settle the amounts payable under the Social Security Scheme, Family Benefit Fund, IRT Contributions and to refund of contributions under the Post Retirement Benefit Scheme together with interest at the rate of 12% within a specified time as may be fixed by this Court.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.K.Raja, learned Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents By consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final hearing.



4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the petitioner's representation is considered on merits and in accordance with law. It is settled law as laid down by various decisions of this Court that in case of delayed payment of retirement benefits, the employee is entitled for 4% interest. While passing the final order, the same may be considered by the respondents.

5. For the forgoing reasons, this Court directs the respondents to



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pass final orders on the petitioner's representation dated 13.06.2022 seeking for payment of interest at the rate of 12% per annum for the belated payment of his PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary, to pay the amounts towards 60 days of earned leave surrendered by the petitioner, while he was in service and to settle the amounts payable under the Social Security Scheme, Family Benefit Fund, IRT Contributions and to refund of contributions under the Post Retirement Benefit Scheme, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the aforesaid direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
