Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2022 to calculate the petitioner's service from the date of his initial appointment on 13.05.1993 and consequently direct the respondents to pay pension and other terminal benefits

ORDER

This Writ petition has been filed for a mandamus seeking for a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2022, requesting the respondents to calculate his service from the date of his initial appointment on 13.05.1993 and consequently direct the respondents to pay the pension and other terminal benefits at the time of his retirement with all consequential benefits and arrears.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Mr.C. Sathish, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. By consent of both the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.



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4. No prejudice will be caused to the respondents if the petitioner's representation is considered on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.



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5. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the respondents to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2022, seeking for regularization of his service from the date of his initial appointment on 13.05.1993 and to pay the pension and other terminal benefits at the time of his retirement with all consequential benefits and arrears, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the aforesaid directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
