Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 12% per annum for the belated payment of his PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary, to pay the amounts towards 30 days of earned leave surrendered by the petitioner, while he was in service and to settle the amounts payable under the Social Security Scheme, Family Benefit Fund, IRT Contributions



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and to refund of contributions under the Post Retirement Benefit Scheme, together with interest at the rate of 12%.

ORDER

By consent of both the parties, this writ petition has been taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. Mr.K. Raja, learned Standing counsel accepts notice for the 1st respondent and Mr.C.S.K. Sathish, learned Government Advocate accepts notice for the 2nd respondent.

3. This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus seeking for payment of interest for the belated payment towards his terminal and pensionary benefits namely PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary etc., to the petitioner, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4. Heard Ms. H.Nandhini, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.K.Raja, learned Standing counsel for the 1st respondent and Mr.C.S.K.Sathish, learned Standing Counsel, for the 2nd respondent.



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5. The petitioner has given representation on 19.09.2022 seeking for payment of interest for the belated payment of his terminal and pensionary benefits namely PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary etc., though he retired from service on 31.05.2019 itself. Since the representation has not been considered till date, he has filed this writ petition.

6. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the petitioner's representation is considered on merits and in accordance with law. It is settled law as laid down by various decisions of this Court that in case of delayed payment of retirement benefits, the employee is entitled for 4% interest. While passing the final orders, the same may be considered by the respondents.

7. For the forgoing reasons, this Court directs the respondents to pass final orders on the petitioner's representation dated 19.09.2022, seeking for payment of interest for the belated payment of his terminal and pensionary benefits namely PF, gratuity, commuted value of pension and earned leave salary etc., within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
