2. Apprehending that, the respondent police is not properly investigating the case and trying to close the First Information Report, the present petition is filed for transferring the investigation.

The Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondents states that, investigation is completed and the draft charge sheet is ready for approval and same is likely to be filed before the appropriate Court within a period of three weeks. In view of the said fact, the apprehension of the petitioner that fair investigation by the respondents will not be done, has proved to be incorrect. Since, the investigation is completed and draft final report is also ready, while disposing the petition for transfer, the respondent is directed to file the final report within a period of three weeks before the competent Court for further proceedings.
