Prayer : Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the first and second respondents to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme of Adal Padal on 12.12.2022 at 6.00PM to 11.00 PM at “Sri Devi Poodevi sametha & Sri Varadharaja Perumal Temple Maha Kumbhabhishekam Festival” Mallarasankuppam Village, Malavanthangal Post, Gingee Taluk, Villuppuram District by consider and pass orders on the representation dated 18.11.2022 made by the petitioner within the time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to give permission and police protection to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of “Sri Devi Poodevi sametha & Sri Varadharaja Perumal Temple Maha Kumbhabhishekam Festival” Mallarasankuppam Village, Malavanthangal Post, Gingee Taluk, Villuppuram District on 12.12.2022 between 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM by considering the petitioner's representation dated 18.11.2022.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct cultural programme on 12.12.2022 between 06.00 pm to 11.00 pm, in the temple festival at “Sri Devi Poodevi sametha & Sri Varadharaja Perumal Temple Maha Kumbhabhishekam Festival” Mallarasankuppam Village, Malavanthangal Post, Gingee Taluk, Villuppuram District, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 18.11.2022 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.



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3. The learned Government Advocate (crl.side), appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 18.11.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition is **disposed of**. No costs.
