For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the second respondent to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law on the petitioner's representation dated 13.11.2021, seeking for revocation of the impugned suspension order dated 22.04.2021, within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in the light of G.O.(Ms).No.81, Human Resources Management (N) Department, dated 04.08.2022.

6. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
