For the foregoing reasons, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the 1st respondent to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law in the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above directions, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
