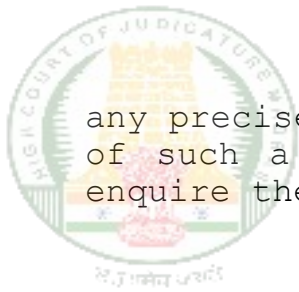
Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the third respondent to forward the petitioner's case records inclusive of the petitioner's complaint dated 30.10.2021 given in connection with the theft of ¾ feet Iympon Amman Idol from Arulmighu Angala Parameshwari Amman (Mathankovil) Temple, Alwarkurichi, Tenkasi District to the second respondent so as to enable him to enquire the same and to proceed further in accordance with law.

Since no action was taken, this writ petition came to be filed. The respondents have filed their counter affidavit controverting the petition averments. In the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition, the petitioner has not given



any precise details. It is quite vague. Therefore, on the strength of such a vague complaint, the respondents cannot be mandated to enquire the matter. The writ petition stands dismissed.
