DECREE:-

(1) That the award passed by the the Motor Accide
Claims Tribunal (I Additional District Judge) (PCR),
Trichirapalli dated 11.11.2005 made in M.C.O.P. No.2848 of
2002 be and hereby is dismissed

(2) That the Appellant herein /Insurance Company be and
hereby is directed to deposit the entire compensation of
Rs.7,81,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Eighty One Thousand
only) (if not already deposited) together with interest at
the rate of 7.5% per annum to the credit of M.C.O.P.
No.2848 of 2002 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims
Tribunal (I Additional District Judge) (PCR),
Tiruchirapalli, within a period of eight weeks from the
date of receipt of a copy of this order, less any amount
already deposited.

(3) That on such deposit being made, by the Appellant
herein / Insurance Company, the respondents / claimants be
and are hereby permitted to withdraw the entire award
amount, with interest as apportioned by the Tribunal and
cost less any amount already withdrawn by them.
