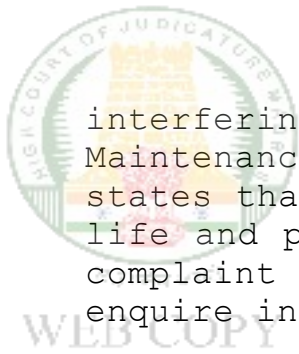

interfering with his legitimate rights. Rule 21 of the Tamilnadu Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Rules, 2009 states that there must be an action plan for the protection of the life and property of senior citizens. The petitioner has given a complaint dated 26.08.2021. The third respondent is directed to enquire into the same.

3.The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
