The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the matter has become infructuous.

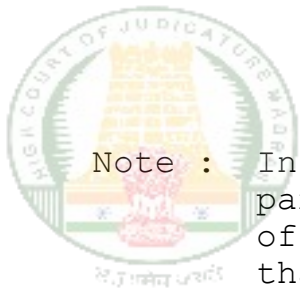
2.Recording the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.
