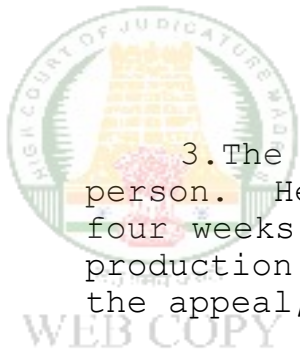
PRAYER in C.M.A(MD)SR.61049 of 2021 :
