Prayer in CRL MP(MD) .No.505 of 2022:-

Petition filed under section 482 of Cr.P.C.,to relax the condition imposed by this Honourable Court in Crl.A.(MD).No. 451 of 2021 dt.09/11/2021 on the file of this Honourable Court.

Prayer in CRL A(MD) .No.451 OF 2021:-

This criminal appeal is filed under section 14-A(2) of the scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Privenion of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015 to set aside the order dt.6.9.2021 made in Cr.M.P.No.1424 of 2021 on the file of the Special Court(Sessions Judge)S.C/S.T.(POA)Act, Srivilliputhur and enlarge the appellant on bail in connection with Criminal Case in Crime No.63 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER:- This Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Thiru. E.Mareees Kumar, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Thiru.K.Sanjai Gandhi, Government Advocate, for the respondents 1 and 2, this Court made the following order:

This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.A.(MD)No.451 of 2021 dated 09.11.2021.

2.On the side of the petitioner, it is stated that this Court has granted bail to the petitioner on 09.11.2021, directing the petitioner to appear before the concerned police Station daily twice



at 10.30 a.m., and 05.00 p.m. It is stated that the petitioner is complying the condition regularly and prayed the petition to be allowed.

3.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent admitted that the petitioner is complying the condition till now.

4.In view of the aforesaid submissions, this Court is inclined to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.A.(MD) No.451 of 2021 dated 09.11.2021. Hence, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is partly allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioner is modified to the effect that the petitioner is directed to appear before the concerned Police Station on first working day of every week at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
