PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.462 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order:-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A1 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under section 379 IPC and section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No.462 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons had illegally transported two units of river sand without any valid permit in the vehicles. Hence, the case.
