She has been duly identified by Ms.S.Chirtravathy, WHC 2081 attached to first respondent police station. The parties have filed a memo of joint compromise. not want to pursue the complaint, no purpose will be served in keeping the impugned prosecution alive. The impugned proceedings stand quashed. The criminal original petition is allowed. The memo of joint compromise will form part of the order.
