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ORDER

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This criminal original petition has been filed for quashing the FIR in Crime No.256 of 2016 registered on the file of the first respondent.

2.The defacto complainant/K.Sekar is present before this Court in person through video conferencing. He has been duly identified by Mr.A.Jeyakumar, Special Sub Inspector of Police attached to first respondent police station. The parties have filed a memo of joint compromise. The defacto complainant categorically states before this Court that he does not want to pursue the complaint. When the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and the defacto complainant does not want to pursue the complaint, no purpose will be served in keeping the impugned prosecution alive. The impugned FIR is quashed. The criminal original petition is allowed. The memo of joint compromise will form part of the order. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
