2.Permission is granted. The criminal revision case is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is at liberty to agitate all the grounds before the trial Court.

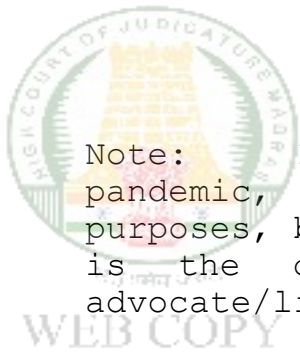
