COMMON ORDER

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has also not shown any interest to find out whether the respondents 1 and 2 alive or not.

2.Since the revision petitions are pending from 2011, these Civil Revision Petitions are dismissed as abated. However, the petitioners are at liberty to take steps to implead the legal representatives of the deceased respondents 1 and 2 in the execution application.



3. With the above liberty, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
