The contention of the petitioner's counsel is that this order is sought to be violated by the private respondents herein. If that be so, the remedy open to the petitioner is before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It may not be proper for this Court to intervene.

3.Leaving open the petitioner's rights and remedies, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
