3. This Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

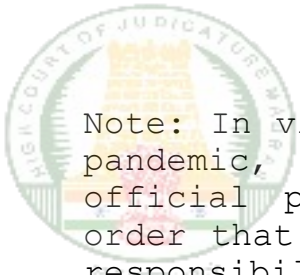
