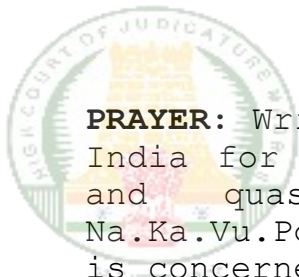

COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions are filed as against the orders of the second respondent District Collector cancelling the licence granted to these petitioners for vending kerosene.

2.No representation for the petitioners in WP(MD)Nos.6071 to 6077 of 2010. Mr.Saravanakumar, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners in W.P(MD)No.9443 and 9444 of 2010, submits that the petitioners were having licence for kerosene vending and the second respondent vide impugned orders have cancelled the said licence for kerosene vending. Aggrieved over the same, these petitions are filed.

3.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submits that earlier the licence for vending kerosene was given and subsequently, the Government has taken a policy decision not to grant licence for the same. Moreover, these writ petitions were filed in the year 2010.

4.Recording the submission of the learned Additional Government Pleader that in view of the policy decision of the Government, now no licence for vending kerosene is granted, these writ petitions are dismissed as no further order is required to be passed. No costs.
