The learned counsel for the petitioner stated that he would file a writ petition by incorporating the correct name in the cause title.

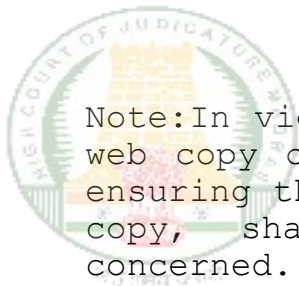
