PRAYER in W.P.(MD)No.11766 of 2012: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned communication dated 24.05.2012 on the file of the third respondent and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to grant permission to conduct the Public Meeting on any day for 4 hours i.e., 6 P.M to 10 P.M at Rahman Street, Authoor - 628151, Thoothukudi District to organize Islamic events, Dowry abolition, interest free loans, and religious discourses.

PRAYER in W.P.(MD)No.11767 of 2012: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned communication dated 24.05.2012 on the file of the third respondent and quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to grant permission to conduct the Blood Donation Camp on any day for 3 hours between 10 A.M to 1 P.M at Kulatthangarai Street, Authoor - 628151, Thoothukudi District.
