3.Hence, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

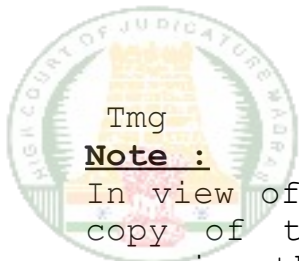
