4. Recording the said submission, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

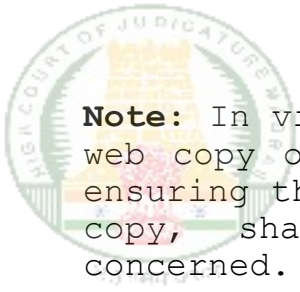
