PRAYER : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the order of the first respondent dated 28.11.2008 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to disburse the death benefits of the petitioner's son Gopal in favour of the petitioner under the Tamil Nadu Agriculture Labour and Farmers and Social Security Welfare Scheme Act, 2006.

ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed challenging an order passed by the second respondent, under which the request of the petitioner for grant of compensation for the death of his son under Tamil Nadu Labours and Agriculture and Farmers Social Security and Welfare Scheme, 2006 was rejected.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is a member under the above said scheme. As per the said scheme, the name of his wife and the son are also recorded in the Identity Card. According to the learned Counsel for the petitioner, if any one of them died due to an accident during the subsistence of the policy, they are entitled to compensation under the said scheme. According to the petitioner, his son, namely, Gopal had passed away
