Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court S-12. To issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the first and second respondents i.e., the Secretary to Government, Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department, Chennai and the Commissioner of Social Welfare, Chennai to pass appropriate orders on the petitioners representation dated 11.11.2020 based on the intimation given to him in letter No. 23756/AD2(3)/2020 dated 22.12.2020 of the Commissioner of Social Welfare, Chennai and the proposals sent by the Joint Director of Collegiate, Education, Madurai Region, Madurai in his letter No.4533/A1/2019 dated 13.09.2019 within a specified time frame that may be fixed by this Honourable Court and pass such further or other orders as may be deemed fit
