4.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition stands allowed. The Compromise Memo shall form part of the record.

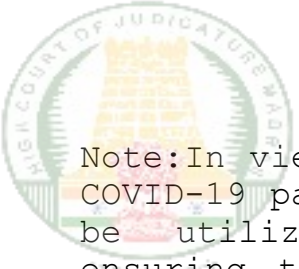
