COMMON ORDER

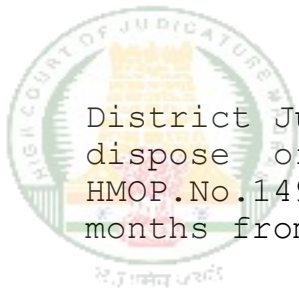
